

If 2011-2012 was considered to be "a transitional year", 2012-2013 should have been a new beginning. However, it was filled with tension, stress and uncertainty. Thanks to our reliable and dependable PER Association and a few individuals who stepped up, we managed to get through the year with vacant chairs and unstaffed committees. But this is NOT how it's supposed to work!

Grand Lodge mandates we have an Exalted Ruler and slate of officers to oversee certain committees and provide guidance throughout the year. We need more members to step up and fill those open chairs and committees. We can't assume that the PER's or for that matter, anyone, will just make sure it happens. Now is the time for YOU to step up and become part of the solution; and not remain as part of the problem.

Last year was a struggle

at times. While we only released six members for non payment of dues, we had far more deletions via death and transfers than additions. We begin 2013-2014 with a membership of 426; down from 439 a year ago. Of those 426 remaining, we had an active participation by only about 25%; and some of those you really wouldn't call "active". We need to change our perspective on getting things done. We need to be aware of the things that Grand Lodge says we must do; the things we would like to do; and the things that we actually do. Our newest members need to honor their commitments; they agreed to join forces with our older members and help out on one or two committees. Better yet, they should formulate a group and become the future leaders for the Lodge. Start with working on a committee or even become a committee chairperson; or become a Lodge officer! Then slowly, work

your way up through the chairs and eventually become the Exalted Ruler or other Chair Officer. Who knows, along the way, you may find it to be a rewarding experience; and, by doing it as a group, the camaraderie that develops cannot be topped. It's no different than committing to coach a Little League team, a soccer team, or a basketball team. All it takes is time, and we all know how precious time is these days. We also know that the advantage of accomplishing something with a group is far easier with a group than doing it by one's self. Fraternally,
