to besides the Elks.

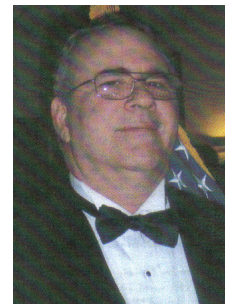
What would happen if
