<h3>Marion Stegmann Fund</h3> <p>Northern school district families are aided by Marion Stegmann Holiday Fund.</p> <p>The season's first snow has covered the ground across Northern Columbia County heralding the approaching holidays, and now local volunteers are busy coordinating activities to ensure the success of the annual Marion Stegmann Fund, which provides essential assistance to needy and less fortunate individuals during the Christmas season.</p> <p>The Marion Stegmann Fund, the legacy of the caring and sharing Niverville lady for whom the program is named, collects and distributes food, toys and good will to those in need in the Ichabod Crane, Chatham, and New Lebanon school districts just prior to Christmas.</p> <p>"It just doesn't seem like Christmas until you feed the needy" was the belief of Mrs. Stegmann. Her holiday program grew over the years to such an extent that she had to reach out to other citizens, churches, businesses and civic organizations to meet the demand for a "lending hand".</p> <p>She readily found that help within her community, including the Kinderhook Elks Lodge 2530, which has spearheaded the tradition for the past 29 years in conjunction with Ghent Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 5933, whose chairman is Ralph Kring.</p>	<p>In 2013, the program's volunteers crisscrossed the three school districts delivering holiday packages to some 300 families consisting of 1300 individuals—a significant increase from the 94 needy families helped in 1986.</p> <p>"The Elks Lodge and our members are proud to be a part of this great benevolent project," said past exalted ruler and current Fund Chairman Paul Martin. "But, without the support of our community and its citizens, this endeavor would not be possible."</p> <p>"The generosity and compassion of so many others, who raise funds, collect non-monetary donations, package and distribute holiday gift and food boxes, allows us to continue to offer help to our fellow citizens at this special time of the year," said Martin.</p> <p>Hundreds of people—young and old and from all walks of life—are involved each year, enthusiastically demonstrating the spirit of the season through their participation," he added.</p> <p>The neighborhood Girl Scouts annually prepare and mail donation letters throughout the region seeking financial support, while Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts partake in a local "Scouting for Food" drive that collects items for distribution to needy families.</p> <p>Martin said the average food basket costs about \$40 each, while a basket with new</p>	<p>toys for each child costs about \$50. Each food basket contains about a week's supply of food.</p> <p>We are fortunate to have the backing of our friends and neighbors, but we gratefully welcome all help, along with suggestions and ideas that would improve our program," the Elks leader said.</p> <p>Donations may be made to: Marion Stegmann Fund, care of the Kinderhook Elks Lodge, PO Box 514, Kinderhook, NY 12106.</p> <p>In addition to the holiday packages, the program provides year-round assistance through its area food pantry.</p> <p>The staging area for the 2014 program will again be at St. Luke's Lutheran Church on Route 9, Valatie, where the delivery week work will begin on December 14th in the church hall. Volunteers will wrap presents and create food packages that will benefit recipients ranging in age from infants to senior citizens. Delivery day is Saturday, December 20th.</p> <p>"For some of these families, the holiday baskets may be the only holiday joy they get," Martin said, appealing to the public to share the spirit of Christmas by supporting "The Fund".</p> <p>For more information or to volunteer, call Paul Martin at 518-653-4522.</p>

New York State Elks Association DEER HIDE PROGRAM

The New York State Elks Association annually collects raw deer hides and the monies gathered from this great program are then distributed, on a monthly basis, to all the veterans hospitals in the state of New York. Donated hides may be dropped off at any local participating Elks Lodge where they will be salted and prepared for the tannery. Rapid deterioration is a big factor so we suggest that no plastic bags be used unless air is allowed to circulate in the bag. The tannery will not accept any hide that has deteriorated so please let us all do our best to keep the hides in shape for the benefit of our hospitalized vets. In return for your hide, a \$35.00 tax deductible certificate will be issued to the individual making the hide donation. There will be a sign-in sheet at each Lodge location which requires your name, address, and license type and number.
