Parties are fun, but then the clean up begins. Thanks to all involved in that project.



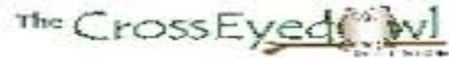
