- If you use a hard copy, return your completed form to the Lodge Secretary.

### The Application Process

#### 1. **Lodge Meeting**

- Your application will be presented at a regular Lodge meeting.

#### 2. **Investigation**

- The Investigating Committee will review your application and contact you to schedule an interview with you and your sponsor.

#### 3. **Membership Vote**

- The committee will present their findings to the Lodge members, who will vote on your application.
- The vote will occur between 10 days and two months after notice is given.

#### 4. **Orientation and Initiation**

- If approved, you and your spouse will be invited to an orientation session, where you'll learn more about the Elks' charitable programs and initiatives.
- Following orientation, you'll attend an initiation ceremony to formally become a member.

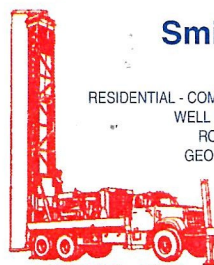

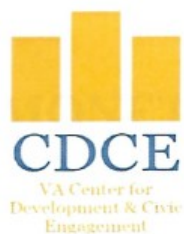
